Unfurl the film from the spool before cutting the film at the end attached to the tank. Then, discard the water. I've only developed Rodinal with or lower speed films. I am starting to see more people using film. The tank, reels, scissors and bottle opener go into the darkroom bag. The tanks I use are about as simple as they come, and I don't really feel like I've ever needed one with any other functions or features.
