East Asia Forum welcomes comments, both for adding depth to analysis and for bringing up important new issues. The transatlantic partners should find new ways of engaging with likeminded Asian partners. Western Germany is filled with government halls and conference centres built with funding from the Marshall plan and the US, flat, utilitarian and clean.

The same is true for Europe, a non-player in Asian geopolitics, for which they have been a major player.
